The Northwest Tennessee Workforce Board has received a Consolidated Business Grant (CBG) to provide funding to local employers to assist them in training their current and/or potential employees through training programs such as Incumbent Worker Training (IWT), On the Job Training (OJT), and Apprenticeship Training Grant (ATG).

(Grant Cycle January 1, 2019-June 30, 2019)



Incumbent Worker Training Grants

Apply for **Incumbent Worker Training Grants** up to \$25,000 to upgrade skills of existing, full-time employees.



On-the-Job Training

Receive referrals for **On-the-Job Training** for eligible new hires with little or no experience. Employers may be reimbursed up to 50% for completion of a short training period.



Apprenticeships Programs

Explore how **Apprenticeships Programs** can provide both on-the-job and classroom training to Employers to prepare individuals to become active, entry-level workers by the end of the program.
